*Color Space*

Richard Levy Gallery is pleased to introduce *Color Space*, an exhibition of works by Jeff Kellar. Using clay, resin and pigment on canvas and mdf constructions he creates pieces that challenge the viewer's beliefs about three-dimensional design. The sculptor takes a reductive approach depicting the existence of space by emphasizing the quality of absence. The audience is captured while not embedded in the pieces, echoing his intentions of dealing with the versatility of spacial barriers, and how these are understood.

The show presents a series of wall pieces, easily read as paintings for they are pinned directly to the wall. Also included are small table top boxes restoring the definition of 'sculpture' for the mainstream. Kellar states that "the wall work and the boxes reference each other. They refer to space in both real and illusionary form. Object and illusion."
