### **Debra Bloomfield**

#### *Oceanscapes*

Richard Levy Gallery is pleased to exhibit a selection from *Oceanscapes*, a series of large-scale color photographs, by San Francisco artist **Debra Bloomfield**.

Bloomfield's work of three decades has consistently explored relations between the internal and external world. *Oceanscapes*, shot by the artist from the exact same location and perspective over the course of years, builds its theme upon one vast horizon of ocean and sky, pursuing its dramatic metamorphoses.

An educator since 1977, Bloomfield is a distinguished guest faculty member at the San Francisco Art Institute and has taught at the University of California, Davis, the University of California, Berkeley, California State University at Hayward, and the California College of Arts and Crafts. Her works is included in several prestigious collections including the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the Boston Fine Arts Museum, and the Contemporary Museum of Art, Honolulu.

Also on display, in the project room, is a selection of photographs from *Imitation of Life* by Finnish artist **Miklos Gaál**. Utilizing an architectural camera, Gaál captures and defamiliarizes the most ordinary human moments, questioning perception and perspective, and making the conceptualization itself the object.
