Tom Waldron New Sculpture

June 24 – August 12, 2005

Richard Levy Gallery is pleased to present *New Sculpture* by widely acclaimed New Mexican artist Tom Waldron.

New Sculpture features Waldron's hand fabricated steel shapes and will include a selection of floor standing, tabletop and wall hanging works. His sculptures, made from sheet steel, become sensual steel slopes with appropriate titles like *Puddle*, *Sluice*, *Shunt*, and *Flume*. *New Sculpture* is Waldron's first gallery exhibition in New Mexico since 1999.

Waldron's steel fabrications are well known across New Mexico, several large works belonging to public collections including the Albuquerque Museum, Albuquerque Public Library, College of Santa Fe, and the State of New Mexico. Waldron's most recent public commission involves shaped earth and water catchment as part of the Louisiana Boulevard/I-40 Interchange renovation. Tom Waldron lives and works in Corrales, New Mexico where he has been a resident for nearly 30 years.

New photographs by Nate Lebowsky will be exhibited in the project room.

An artist reception will be held on Friday, June 24, 2005, 6 - 8pm.

Richard Levy Gallery will publish a full color catalog of Tom Waldron's recent works in the fall of 2005.
